

AREA COUPLE RECEIVE NATIONAL BOAT RACING AWARDS

An Okeechobee couple received Certificates of Achievement at the recent meeting of POWERBOAT SUPERLEAGUE held in Cartersville, GA.

CAROLE RENO finished 4th overall in the very competitive FORMULA 3 class (90 mph) during the 2008 season, racing against 20 drivers from 11 states and Canada. She competed in races in High Point, NC, Marietta, OH, Aurora, IN, Kankakee, IL and Hamilton, OH.

Her husband, JEFF RENO finished 9th in the larger FORMULA 2 Class capable of speeds up to 115 mph racing against 26 drivers from the United States and Latvia.

Both the Renos are long time participants on the Superleague Tour having both started in the Formula 3 Class in 1990. Both Jeff and Carole have participated in over 30 consecutive Superleague races.

POWERBOAT SUPERLEAGUE is the oldest privately-owned boat racing circuit, where tunnel boats perform at top speed as drivers pursue points and prize money. From the opening race in High Point, NC and concluding in Hamilton, OH in 2008, the tour celebrated its 22nd Anniversary and 135 racing events.
